The York County Children's Advocacy Center is an independent, non-profit organization that provides a comprehensive program of forensic interviews, medical examinations, interagency coordination, and referrals for children affected by sexual or physical abuse and their families.

The **Child Forensic Interviewer** conducts interviews of children where there are allegations of sexual or physical abuse. This position will work closely with law enforcement and child welfare services to oversee a collaborative process. Responsibilities include interviewing children and adolescents while police officers, prosecutors, and caseworkers observe, generating reports summarizing interviews and providing court testimony as required. The interviewer may conduct CSEC (Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children) assessments. The position will also assist with case tracking and review, assisting with the general day-to-day activities of the Children's Advocacy Center and promoting and advocating for the programs offered through the Center.

Requirements

- Masters Degree preferred in social work, psychology, or related fields, plus a minimum of two years experience working with children, Bachelor's considered with significant experience.
- Exceptional writing skills a must.
- Good organizational, communication, and networking skills.
- Successful completion of a background check, including PA State Criminal, ChildLine and FBI clearances.
- Working knowledge, experience, and expertise in child abuse issues preferred
- Experience and training in forensic interviewing preferred.
- Experience with the criminal justice system preferred.
- Bi-lingual (Spanish) an asset.

The Center will provide Forensic Interviewer training in a nationally recognized Protocol if candidate does not have training. Candidate must be willing and able to attend a week-long out-of state training, dates to be confirmed pending hire.
